2021 Asian Championships in Artistic Gymnastics and Trampoline Gymnastics cancelled

Dear Members of the Authorities,
Dear Presidents of Federations and Unions,

The Asian Gymnastics Union (AGU) informed the International Gymnastics Federation (FIG) that the following continental championships, serving also as qualifying events for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games, will not take place:

Artistic Gymnastics:

- The 2021 Asian Championships are cancelled.

The FIG will confirm the reallocation of unused quota places (related to criteria 7 of the Olympic qualification system) once the Apparatus World Cup series (criteria 5) is completed.

Trampoline Gymnastics:

- The 2021 Asian Championships are cancelled.

This cancellation has no effect on the Olympic qualification system.

About the FIG: The International Gymnastics Federation is the governing body for Gymnastics worldwide. It is the oldest established international federation of an Olympic sport and has participated in the Olympic Games since their revival in 1896. The FIG governs eight sports: Gymnastics for All, Men's and Women's Artistic Gymnastics, Rhythmic Gymnastics, Trampoline - including Double Mini-trampoline and Tumbling -, Aerobics, Acrobatics, and Parkour.
